Mrs McLean in our Textiles Technology room would be grateful for any old buttons you may have at home. This will help students to learn the skill of sewing on buttons! Thank you.

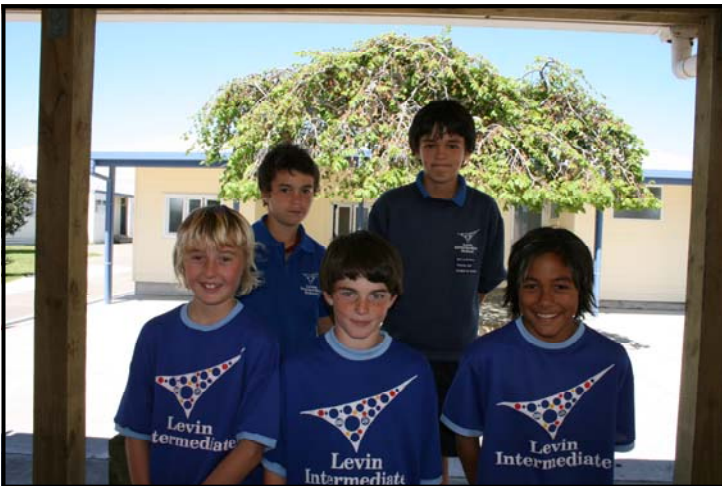

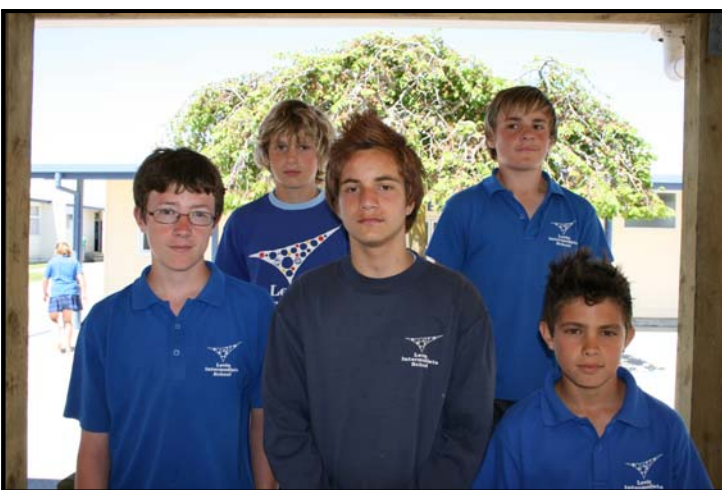
